

Real-Time Determination of a Building's Indicative Energy Performance Class and Automation of Energy Performance Indicator Monitoring



The aim of the project is to gain a better overview of the energy performance of Estonia's building stock, increase the number and reliability of energy performance certificates, and improve both the quality of calculated energy performance certificates and construction quality. The project supports the objectives set out in the Estonia 2035 strategy and the European Union's broader climate policy, helping Estonia move towards climate neutrality. As part of the project, automated solutions will be tested and developed to improve the collection, analysis and verification of data on the energy performance of the building stock.
